
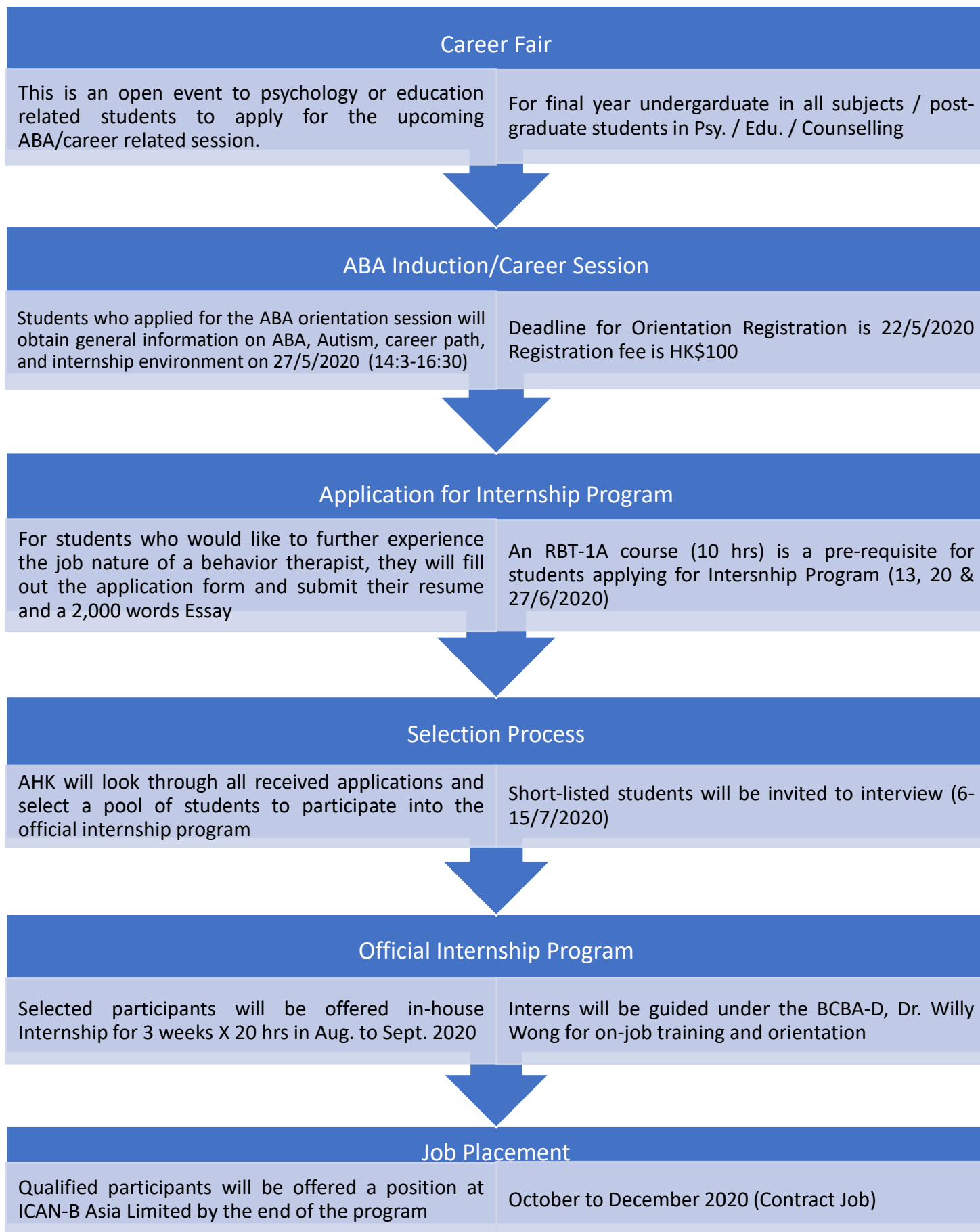

An ABA Internship Program for EduHK Students in Hong Kong

Objective	:	To provide ABA induction session, career orientation and internship opportunities for university graduates who are interested to join the behavior analysis profession to work with children with autism and related developmental disabilities both in Hong Kong and China.
Period	:	July – Dec. 2020
Target	:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Final year under-graduate students in all subjects • Post-graduate students of Psychology, Education & Counselling • Chinese speaking (Cantonese or Putonghua) • Non-Chinese speaking graduates would also be considered

- **Background History of the ICAN-B Asia Limited and its mother organization in the US** – Dr. Jose Davila and Juan Davila launched the ICAN-B project in August 2015. The organization started providing services in the Los Angeles County region. The purpose behind this project was to extend the use of the science of behavior across all possible areas to make humanitarian contributions. Currently, the organization has expanded to Orange, Ventura, and San Mateo County. The organization has also launched soccer and social skill programs. Aside from behavioral services, soccer, and social skill camps, the organization is also launching animation projects that will carry a message of global unity and important social messages for children all around the world.
