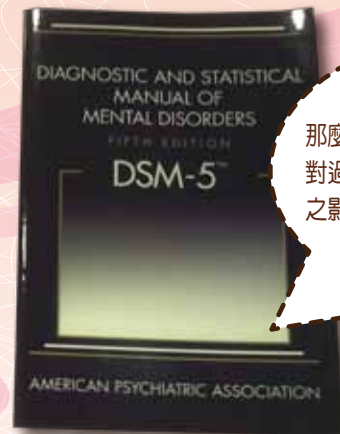


「美國精神疾病診斷及統計手冊第五版」工作坊-- 新一章「腦發展疾病」對評估及介入的啟示

Workshop on DSM-5's New Chapter on Neuro-developmental Disorders—

- How are the severity of autistic symptoms to be assessed
- The future roles for the various diagnostic tools and instruments
- The implications for people diagnosed/ acknowledged to be Asperger Syndrome (still exist?)
- The possible impacts on the prevalence and management for clients suffering from autism
- How the Attention-deficit and Disruptive Behaviour Disorders are splitted up?
- The new concepts about Oppositional Defiant Disorder and Conduct Disorder
- The shift in the understandings about how these childhood psychopathologies evolve into adulthood
- How to handle multiple diagnoses in DSM-5
- What will happen to the DSM IV diagnoses made before and the messages to be released to the clients and families

Speaker Profile

Dr. William FAN Tak Wing is a specialist in psychiatry currently in private practice. He established the Psychiatric Services for Intellectual Disabilities in the Hospital Authority NTWC Cluster for over 10 years and has been enthusiastically committed to improving the clinical services, training, parent support as well as public awareness of autism in Hong Kong.

Dr. Fan has been the convener of the working group for the Hong Kong Autism Awareness Weeks since 2003 and is the president of the Hong Kong Autism Awareness Alliance since 2008. He has been actively involved in delivering public talks as well as organizing scientific symposia on various aspects of autism. He has given strong support for the empowerment of parent and self advocacy in Hong Kong.

He is also a Council member of the Academy of Family Therapy and council member of the Fu Hong Society. He was Adjunct Associate Professor in Psychology and Counselling of the Shue Yan University. He is also registered clinical supervisor of the Asian Professional Counselling Association (HK), President of Hong Kong Animal Therapy Foundation.
