Whichever way you choose to look at it, statistics (whether it's 1:100 or 1:166 children born) indicate that autism is relevant to you directly or indirectly through another person you know. What a waste to see a child's potential held back because of a misdiagnosis or inappropriate special needs labeling, when early screening and intervention could head off the disorder in a large number of cases. This is a multi-dimensional battle waged on multiple fronts.

For parents, renowned experts from leading institutions, including Harvard Medical School, will be sharing with you how biomedical intervention can help children with Autism Spectrum Disorder. The conference will also provide succinct briefing on latest behavioural intervention therapy including Verbal Behaviour and Applied Behavioural Analysis.

Specially arranged workshops for parents and medical practitioners will be held.

Speakers include:

Dr Ken Bock

Dr Ken Bock received his medical degree with honors from the University of Rochester. He is an experienced DAN clinician, whose expertise lies in bringing a comprehensive integrative medicine approach to complex medical problems. Utilizing this patient-centered approach he has helped thousands of children on the road to recovery.

Dr Jeff Bradstreet

Dr Bradstreet is the founder of the International Child Development Resource Center in Florida. He is an Adjunct Professor of Neurosciences at Stetson University. His interests in autism include metal detoxification, hyperbarics and immunological management of gastrointestinal problems.

Mr Stephen Shore

Mr Shore was diagnosed to have autism at young age. He obtained a special education degree in Boston University. He actively participates in work relating to the education, social aspects, employment and right of autistic people.

Dr Martha Herbert

Dr Martha Herbert is a Pediatric Neurologist at Massachusetts General Hospital (Harvard Medical School) and is on the Faculty of Harvard Medical School. She specializes in children with learning and developmental disorders. In this lecture she discusses the growing body of research demonstrating biomedical problems like inflammation and oxidative stress in Autism which suggests that the brain may not be the prime target but rather caught in the crossfire of system-wide abnormalities whose treatment can lead to improved brain function

Dr Jacqueline McCandless

Dr Jacqueline McCandless is certified by the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology. She wrote "Children with Starving Brains: A Medical Treatment Guide for Children with Autism Spectrum Disorders. She teaches and lectures widely on the biomedical treatment of Autism. In this lecture she will explain the key principals of the biomedical assessment and treatment of Autism.

Dr Elizabeth Mumper

Dr Elizabeth Mumper, MD is a general pediatrician and CEO of Advocates for Children. Current clinical research projects include investigating intestinal biopsies in children with autism and correlating gut pathology with methylation and immune abnormalities

Dr James Neubrandner

Dr James Neubrandner is board-certified in Environmental Medicine with special interests in heavy metals and folate/B12 chemistry. He has pioneered the use of Vitamin Methyl B12 in the treatment of Autism and evaluated over 75,000 injections of Methyl B12. It is his opinion that there are certain factors that must be in place, or avoided, for clinicians and parents to realize optimal benefits.

Dr James Partington

Dr James Partington is the Director of an agency specialised in applied behavioural analysis and verbal behaviour. He has over 25 years of experience in the field and is a renowned expert in treating autism and speech difficulties. Treatment approaches grounded in ABA/ VB are now considered to be at the forefront of educational interventions for children with Autism. Dr Partington also provides comprehensive behavioural training to therapists through his agency.

Dr Doreen Granpeesheh

Dr Granpeesheh founded The Centre for Autism and Related Disorders. Through its 17 branches all over the world, the centre has provided diagnosis, assessment and ABA treatment to over 5,000 children.

Dr Andrew Levinson

Dr. Levinson is an Advanced DAN Practitioner and an orthomolecular psychiatrist as well as a yoga master. One of the most controversial and misunderstood treatments for autism is chelation and detoxification. Dr. Levinson will teach how these poisons affect the biochemistry, how to support the weakened system with nutritional interventions and how to effectively and safely detoxify and chelate these poisons to lead to recovery.

Dr David Quig

Dr. Quig received his PHD in Nutritional Biochemistry from the University of Illinois. He is currently Vice President, Scientific Support for Doctor's Data, and has recently co-authored and facilitated several studies pertaining to toxic and essential elements in children with autism and learning/behavioral disorders.
