Abstract: Touch Trust is a pioneering charity offering unique & creative movement education programs primarily for children & adults with profound & multiple disabilities, including Autistic Spectrum Disorders, complex needs and behaviour which challenges. It is an art of movement program with the belief that music is very important. Through artistic practices, Touch Trust Programme brings about expression, empowerment, wellbeing, happiness & social & other developments.



Speaker: Dilys Price created her unique Art of Movement programme based on 40 years of experience in the field of dance education and founded Touch Trust in 1997. She is the Director of Touch Trust and continues to oversee and develop the programme on a daily basis.

She was the Special Needs and Dance tutor for many years for the British Association of Lecturers and Advisers in Physical Education, and Chairman of British Amateur Gymnastics (producing Recreational Gymnastic Awards for Special Needs). In Wales, she was part of a team which founded and built the Wales Sports Centre for the Disabled (UWIC). She was a founder member of the Wales Sports Association for Special Needs and was a consultant for Movement Activities for a variety of special needs. In 2003 she was awarded the OBE for Services to the Disabled.
