Tristan Chan qualified as an Art Psychotherapist in the UK with a professional membership of BAAT, and is registered with the Health Professional Council in the UK. She has experience with children and young people in the severe mental health unit in the National Health Service in the UK. She also has experience of working with adults with learning disabilities, refugees, ethnic minority groups and women and children who had suffered from domestic abuse. She has undertaken art training in Canada, Australia and the UK, as well as in Hong Kong.

Achievement:

- 1) To be able to understand the principal of art therapy practice
- 2) To be able to experience art making and the therapeutic process
- 3) To have an insight of how to apply art therapy services

Art therapy offers a safe place for the service user to explore their creativity and imagination. Art therapist supports the client to make sense to their feeling that has been provoked during art making process, and by sharing of their images, the clients would have a better insight of what is going on in their lives. Art Therapist will act as a mirror to reflect the content, feelings, emotions, and stories about the image.

Autism - an umbrella term for a wide range of disorders. Clinically, they may be referred to as "Pervasive Developmental Disorders" (PDDs) or "Autism Spectrum Disorders." Generally, these disorders are defined by deficits in three core areas: social skills, communication, and behaviors and/or interests.

Art, as a non-verbal communication mean, is able to contain the feelings of the maker, and reflect to the third party in a direct but imaginative way. It is very useful for people with Autism spectrum to focus into art making process without any disturbances from the outside world, and the image itself is communicating with the outside world.

Who should attend: The workshop is designed for social workers, teachers, health care professionals, rehabilitation workers, parents and carers, and anyone is interested in art psychotherapy. The workshop will also discuss how you can introduce art therapy service or using art in your service settings.

Through the workshop, you will be able to learn the basic theories and principals of art psychotherapy, and also to experiences the art making and therapeutic process. You do not need to be good at art. The art therapist will support you to explore using art materials in your own way. Be open-minded and enjoy the freedom of using art materials in different ways. You will participate in different art making process including individual and group setting. Moreover, you will gain different ideas from the case study regarding using art with children with Autism spectrum.

*Please be aware that this is **NOT** an art therapist training, you will not be qualified as an art therapist after attending the Pre-seminar workshop.
